We ask that the letters adhere to the following guidelines: They must include the submitters name, email, home (street) address, and telephone number (day and night, if different) of the author. No letter will be published under an assumed name although a Name Withheld by Request may be requested. Letters must not contain libelous material. Letters should be no longer than about 300 words (about 600 words for guest editorials) and should be typed into either an email or a Word doc. We reserve the right to edit or reject outright letters if they are too long or if they contain statements that are unnecessarily offensive or obscene, this includes hate and abusive personal attacks.
